<u>Fossils</u> – Children in Year 5 and 6 have been investigating the life and work of Mary Anning, the famous fossil hunter from the 19<sup>th</sup> Century. She lived in Lyme Regis and found and identified many pre-historic fossils from the time of the dinosaurs. She was the first person to uncover a full Ichthyosaurus skeleton and it is now on display in the Natural History Museum.

<u>South America</u> – Children in Year 3 and 4 have started their topic on South America. This week they have been looking at all the different countries that make up the Continent – do you know them all?!
