Bishopswood Visit – Pupils in Year 5 and 6 visited Bishops Wood on Wednesday to experience life in the Stone Age. They made shelters, hunted ‘animals’ and gathered ‘berries’. Children also made fires using flints, mastered willow weaving and ground wheat to make flour. Thank you to our fantastic volunteers for supporting our trip.
