<u>Girls Football</u> – Our girl's football team took part in a "Just Play" football session on Tuesday, which has been set up by the lionesses who want to leave a legacy of giving every girl up and down the country the opportunity of accessing football in and out of school. They played a number of matches without conceding a goal. Thank you to parents for transport and support.

<u>Science Day</u> – On Thursday a group of Year 4 children attended an Ogden Trust Science day at Mappleborough Green Primary School. They took part in a variety of activities including 'Viscosity Cylinders', 'Cheerios States of Matter', 'Blow-up Balloons' and 'Solid, Liquid and Gas Balloons'. The children learnt about the atoms in solids, liquids and gases and enjoyed taking part in the different investigations and experiments.

<u>Wellbeing</u> – LKS2 pupils took part in workshops lead by the Educational Mental Health Practitioners this week, looking at anxiety, what the warning signs are and strategies to use when feeling anxious. We are also very excited to be starting a Mental Health committee with children from all classes from Year 1 to Year 6 nominating a representative from their class.

<u>Superheroes</u> - As part of their topic about Superheroes, the Reception children have been reading the story of Supertato! They have been making posters with messages and designing traps to catch the evil pea! The children are looking forward to their superhero dressing up day on Tuesday 28th November. If you have any plain pillow cases that you no longer need, please send them into school for us to use. We will be working with the children to decorate the pillow cases using fabric pens, to use as capes for superhero role play costumes.

<u>Nativity</u> – Children in KS1 have been practising the nativity this week, the singing is coming along nicely and they have been very good at learning their lines. Tickets for the performances have been sent out. If you have tickets that you do not need, please drop them in to the office so that we can give them to other families.

<u>English</u> - UKS2 class have been doing descriptive writing using figurative language, about the slums outside of Johannesburg. LKS2 have been researching and writing about one of three endangered animals, the choice was snow leopard, red panda or blue whale.

<u>Reception Disco</u> – Children in Reception will be having their disco on Wednesday 6th November as part of their wellbeing day. They should come into school in their PE kit, they <u>do not</u> need to bring a change of clothes for the disco.
