<u>Reception</u> –have enjoyed their book of the week "Whatever Next" as an introduction into their topic on space. They have been retelling the story and have used it as a theme for the display board in the corridor. This week the children have been learning more about the planets in our solar system and produced some pictures of planets using paint, colour washes and tissue paper. The children are showing a keen interest in learning more about space.

<u>KS1</u> -have been thinking about friendship in collective worship and what makes a good friend. Some of the answers included trust, being kind, sharing and being there for one another. KS1 have welcomed Miss Seymour who is a 3rd year student at Worcester University and will be with us for 8 weeks for her final placement.

<u>KS2</u> – LKS2 have been learning about types of rocks including igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic rocks and how they are formed and UKS2 have been learning pet names in French.



Science Day – Some of the Reception children went to an Ogden Trust Science Day at Tardebigge School with Mrs Deguara this week. They had an exciting day making planets out of playdough and created rockets using paper straws which they moved by blowing through the straws. They also painted planets using marbles as their paint brush.



<u>Santa Run</u> – Well done to everyone who took part in the Santa Run before Christmas to raise money for The Shakespeare Hospice. The total amount raised was £2142.45, which is a fantastic amount. Alison from the Shakespeare Hospice will be coming in to school on the 1st February to thank the children for supporting their charity and to share how the money raised will support families.

<u>Curriculum Overviews</u> – We have recently updated the school website with our curriculum polices, overviews and progression maps (https://www.bidfordonavon.warwickshire.sch.uk/foundationsubjects.htm). This provides a clear overview of what is covered in our curriculum and how the skills and knowledge develop over their time at our school. We have also developed an overview showing how the EYFS provision feeds in to the National Curriculum, and skills taught in KS1. Children will shortly be bringing home their curriculum overviews giving details of the subject areas that they will be covering this term.
