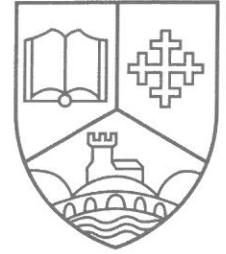


# Bidford on Avon Church of England Primary School
