

## **NEWSLETTER 4 – 27<sup>th</sup> September 2019**

Dear Parents, Pupils & Governors,

**Owl Babies** – After reading the ‘Owl Babies’ story the week children in Reception have made their own ‘Owl Babies’ from rice cakes decorated with icing, raisins, carrot, apple, cereal and chocolate buttons. Children were able to explore different shapes and how they can be used to make patterns.

**Maths Rapid Recall Targets** - To support children’s understanding of our number system we are using a resource called Rapid Recall. Children from Year 2 to Year 6 have been issued with targets relating to each of the steps in the resource. Today they will have brought home a letter introducing which step they are on and details about each of the targets within that step to help you support them at home with their learning. Children take part in weekly classroom activities to develop their fluency in the number steps.

**Phonics** – On Wednesday Mrs Ellwood held a meeting for Reception parents to explain how we support their children with their reading through our Phonics programme.

**School Meals** – We will be serving a Pupil Favourites lunch menu on Thurs 3<sup>rd</sup> Oct - Pizza or Twisty Pasta with Tomato Sauce served with Potato Wedges, Salad and Sweetcorn. Cookie, Ice Cream, yoghurt or Fresh Fruit.

**School Safety** – Please help to keep our children safe when they are coming to and from school by:

- Walking through the **pedestrian gate** and not through the vehicle exit.

- Parking in Wards Lane carpark, only a short walk away behind the Fire Station.
- Not blocking access by stopping in the entrance/ exit gates.
