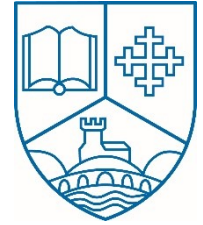

Light Workshop – On Wednesday, children in Miss Butler’s and Miss Eyles’ class took part in a virtual science workshop led by Dr Jenny Watson. During the session pupils took part in a range of activities exploring light including making a kaleidoscope, setting up fair tests to see how different materials make different shadows and seeing how shadows change when the light source moves closer and further away. The children asked Dr Jenny lots of good questions and thoroughly enjoyed the workshop.
