

Enrichment Days – Pupils from Year 1 to 6 have enjoyed participating in our enrichment days and had great fun joining in with a range of sports activities including POUND, Kanjam and Street Dance. They also participated in a Wellbeing workshop which was funded by the BSA. The feedback from the children has been lovely and they have really enjoyed the sessions.
