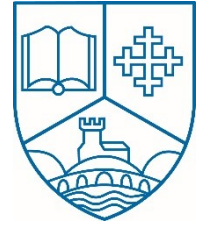

Diwali - The Reception children have had an exciting and interesting time learning about Diwali. They have participated in many different activities such as creating rangoli patterns, window decorations, mehndi patterns, food tasting and making clay divas.

RE Day – Children in Year 5 and 6 class have been learning about the Five Pillars of Islam in their RE day this week. They found out about the Hajj, fasting for the festival of Ramadan and learnt how Muslims pray. Mrs Satchwell's class were lucky enough to learn more from one of the children who brought in her prayer mat and her headscarf to show everyone.

Science Day – Some of the Year 1 children took part in an Ogden Trust science day at Mount Carmel School today. They explored gravity and forces through practical activities including building towers from spaghetti and marshmallows and making rocket mice to launch from plastic bottles.
