Dear Parents, Pupils & Governors,

<u>Ancient Egypt</u> – Children in Years 3 and 4 have been learning about mummification. The process was an important part of the Ancient Egyptian life cycle. There were steps to follow in order to complete the mummification process properly and in order for the body and soul to be united once again. The children enjoyed a practical demonstration using rather a lot of toilet rolls in the process! Children in Years 5 and 6 have looked at the importance of the Nile. Taking the role of different Ancient Egyptians, the children wrote speeches about why they should look after the River Nile and how it is important to the environment.

<u>Computing</u> - Over the past few weeks, children in years 5 and 6 have been learning about cryptography. They have cracked codes, looked at using semaphores and Morse Code. This week they have been finding out how Caesar Cyper works - the children have really enjoyed exploring the topic.

<u>Tree Planting</u> – On Thursday, Mrs Moore and a group of KS2 children helped Wendy Shaddick and her community team plant over 100 tree saplings into pots. The trees will be planted around the village next year, as part of our village's 'Plant a Tree for the Jubilee' initiative.

<u>Superhero Day</u> – Reception children enjoyed celebrating Superheros on Thursday. They made superhero masks, got involved with making obstacle courses and superhero vehicles using crates and tyres. The children also put together a circuit to make a light bulb light up using their super powers.
