<u>Science Day</u> – Last week a group of Year 5 children attended an Ogden Trust Science day at Mappleborough Green Primary School. They took part in a variety of activities including 'Viscosity Cylinders', 'Cheerios States of Matter', 'Blow-up Balloons' and 'Solid, Liquid and Gas Balloons'. The children learnt about the atoms in solids, liquids and gases and enjoyed taking part in the different investigations and experiments.

<u>British Museum</u> – On Monday, Year 5 & 6 pupils had an exciting day at the British Museum in London. They attended a workshop about Greek myths and legends and explored the stories depicted on some of the pottery pieces in the museum. After lunch, they looked at the ancient Greek artefacts and saw the Parthenon Sculptures (Elgin Marbles) up close. The children were a credit to our school and Mrs Mills, Miss Powell and Miss Waters would like to say a huge thank you to the teaching assistants and volunteers who came on the trip with them.
