<u>Chinese New Year</u> – The Reception children have been learning about the Lunar New Year and how it is prepared for and celebrated in China. Their learning ended with surprising the rest of the school with a dragon parade through almost every classroom making their own music using drums and cymbals.

The children in Year 5 and 6 are very excited about seeing what is inside!

One robot even had a portal that was a time machine allowing users to travel back and forward in time.
