<u>Reception</u> – The Reception children discovered an outline of flour in Mrs Roberts' classroom and a special type of cookie cutter. The trail led them to the story of The Gingerbread Man. They have enjoyed reading the story and talking about the story setting, characters and events. They have been learning to retell the story in their own words.

<u>KS1</u> – In Art, Mr Plumbe's class have created a beach landscape focusing on foreground, midground and background. These are drying ready for the lighthouses, boats and other seaside objects to be added. Year 1 and Year 1/2 will enjoy starting these next week.
