**<u>Reception</u>** – have been reading the stories of Oliver's Fruit Salad and The Enormous Watermelon. Some children went to the Co-op to purchase a selection of fruit, we then used our senses to explore the fruit and made some careful observational drawings of the outside and insides of various fruits. We also made a fruit salad to taste, which the children thoroughly enjoyed. As part of our VE celebrations we made a red, white and blue themed hat to wear for our picnic lunch.

<u>KS1 (Y1, Y1/2 & Y2)</u> – have been enjoying learning about VE day and have been researching about the importance of this event and why we celebrate it. We have also made hats and flags to enjoy at our picnic. In addition, this week we have started; Bob, Man on The Moon! The children have really enjoyed asking questions and pretending to be Bob (we had some fantastic impressions). In maths, we have started learning about fractions. Year 2 have been finding a half, a quarter and a third of shapes and amounts.

**LKS2 (Y3, Y3/4 & Y4)** —have worked hard in their final week of the half term. They have explored shape poems, thinking about how language and colours are used to create a vivid image. In Geography, they have explored the deadly features of volcanos. We have loved sharing our picnic lunches today, learning about VE day and designing our own medals. Thank you to all of our families for supporting us this half term. Have a restful break.

**KS2 (Y5, Y5/6 & Y6)** – Year 5 impressed everyone as they performed the songs they've been learning with Warwickshire Sings. Their hard work and enthusiasm shone through, and they sounded fantastic in front of their proud parents and carers. Meanwhile, Year 6 students have now auditioned and been cast in this year's school play, *Pirates of the Curry Bean*, and will begin rehearsing their roles in the weeks ahead. In English, the children have been exploring the London Eye as part of their work on persuasive writing, getting ready to create exciting and informative leaflets.
