<u>Reception</u> – have been sharing the story of "The Gingerbread Man" and have joined in enthusiastically with repeated phrases within the story. They have created their own pictures of The Gingerbread Man and are very much looking forward to baking gingerbread men to eat next week. They also explored and discovered the reason why the gingerbread man did not swim across the river in the story!



KS1 (Y1, Y1/2 & Y2) – have continued their Transport topic, learning about cars, trains and planes from the past and present. In addition, we have been looking at a significant individual in the history of transport: Amelia Earhart. The children really enjoyed learning about her and what she achieved. In English, we have been writing postcards from ... THE MOON! During our Bob: Man on the Moon topic, we have looked at what it was like on the moon for Bob, how it may have felt and wrote a postcard to his friends. The children produced some really excellent work!

<u>LKS2 (Y3, Y3/4 & Y4)</u> —have started their new text 'The Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpurgo. The children have loved the first few chapters and their work about whether they should keep a pet lion! In topic, the children have been learning about why it would or would not be a good idea to live near a volcano. In Science, the children looked at the structure of a leaf and now know how water is transported through them. Ask them about the different parts of a leaf!

KS2 (Y5, Y5/6 & Y6) – Year 6 have begun rehearsals for their exciting end-of-year play, *Pirates of the Curry Bean*. In class, they've also been busy writing persuasive information leaflets about the London Eye, inspired by our new book *The London Eye Mystery*. Meanwhile, Year 5 have been exploring the classic poem *The Highwayman* and are now creatively retelling it in their own words, transforming poetry into powerful narrative writing.


Free Courses
