

Year 1 - Ogden Science trip

This week some of our Year 1 students explored forces like push, pull, gravity and motion through fun, hands-on activities. They made rocket mice-paper cones launched by squeezing plastic bottles to push air and make them fly. Then they built spaghetti and marshmallow towers, learning about gravity and balance as they aimed for the tallest structure. With balancing parrots, students added blue tac to find the perfect weight for balance. They also made paper spinners weighted with paper clips to see how objects spin and fall. Finally, hoop gliders made from paper loops and straws floated through the air, demonstrating flight and air resistance. It was a fantastic day full of discovery and creativity!




