Count in 5s and fill in the missing numbers on the hands.

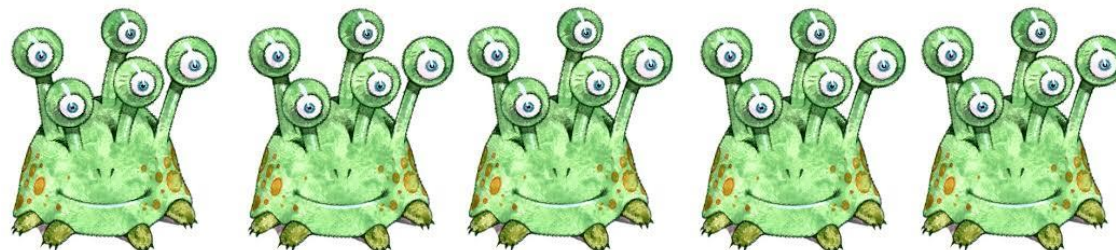
