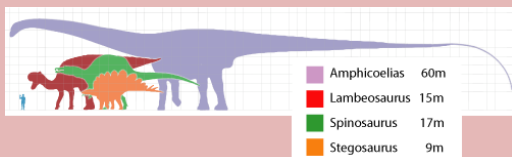
Comprehension: Read through the information and answer the related comprehension questions

Sort Dinosaurs into herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.

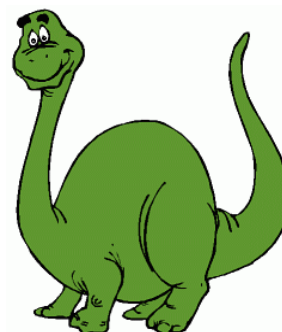
