

## English

- Write a biography on a famous person of your choice – this could be a sports person, politician, actor or singer etc.
- Choose a famous poet to look at – read some of their poetry and have a go at creating a poem in the style of them.
- Write a diary in role of a famous person who has made a great achievement in their life. E.g. Neil Armstrong the day he landed on the moon

- Persuasive writing- You're stuck on a desert island! You can choose three famous people to stay on there with you. Explain who and why, giving good reasons for your choices. E.g. Bear Grylls to make campfires and hunt food.

## Science

- Research famous scientists such as: Albert Einstein, Charles Darwin, Isaac Newton, Marie Curie, Stephen Hawking, Thomas Edison and Alexander Bell. Find out what they achieved for science – *what discoveries did they make?*

## History

- Research the main events of Christopher Columbus' discovery of America and have a go at writing a recount.
- Use information sources to find out about Sir Edmund Hillary and his conquest of Mount Everest.
- Research the lives of Florence Nightingale or Mary Seacole – what were their main life events.

## Geography

- Use Google Maps to locate where a famous person was born/lived/died/explored/worked – can you find out what continent the country is in, where the nearest city is? Etc.

## RE

- Read a bible story to find out about a chosen person such as Moses, Joseph, Mary, Daniel, David etc. Have a go at creating a storyboard to depict what happens in the story.

## Music

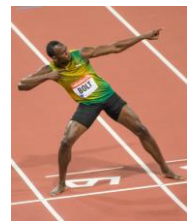
- Listen to a different genre of music such as Rock, Pop, Motown or Classical. Find out about a musician from this genre – *what got them interested in music? Which instruments can they play?*

E.g. Bill Withers or Ed Sheeran



## PE

- Choose a famous sports person to research – find out how they got into their chosen sport/what it took to become successful?
- Create a poster to encourage people to join a sport after finding out what it takes to become a professional.
- Usain Bolt is the fastest runner in the world – have a go at timing yourself running 100m. Can you get any quicker and beat your time?



## Computing

- Create a PowerPoint about a famous person who has inspired you. Explain why they have. What have they done to change other's lives?

## Art/DT

- Find out about the life of any artist such as Picasso, Degas, Goldsworthy, Manet and Monet. How did they become an artist? What type of art did they produce?
- Have a go at copying a particular piece of work by your chosen artist.
- Create a portrait of a famous person in the style of Picasso.



## Maths

- Choose a famous person to find out how long they have been/were alive for – can you work it out in years, months, days etc.
- Look at which month's famous scientists or inventors were born in and create a table/graph to compare. Is there a particular month that is more popular?
