

## English

- Create a fact file/ leaflet about how to care for a pet.
- Write a short story from the perspective of an animal.
- Write a poem about an animal or pet of your choice.
- Design calligrams (shape poems) for different animals.
- Write a description about a pet or other animal.

## History

- Research about the origins of different dog breeds.
- Learn about how and why some animals were so important in World War One.
- Find out why cats had such an important role in Ancient Egypt.
- Investigate how people came to have domesticated cats as pets.

## RE/ PSHE

- Explore issues surrounding animal right and express your own views on the subject.
- Find different references to animals in the bible.
- Learn about the parable of 'The Lost Sheep' and retell the story using a storyboard or comic strip.

## PE

- Create a dance to show the movements of different animals.
- Practise moving in different ways e.g. running, crawling, hopping etc. to represent different animals.
