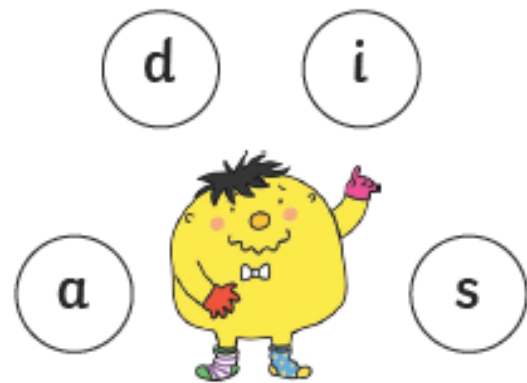
The 'Oxford Owl for Home' website (Click [here](#)) has a free library of tablet friendly e-books.
