Covid 19 Behaviour policy amendments:

Along with our usual behaviour policy children are expected to comply with the arrangements put in place to limit the spreads of coronavirus, including social distancing, handwashing and hygiene and the daily management of movement around the class and school and the use of resources.

Additional school rules:

- Wash your hands regularly as directed
- Stay inside your class 'bubble' all day - especially at break and lunchtime
- Tell an adult if you feel unwell
- Sneezing/ coughing – use tissues to 'Catch it, kill it, bin it!'
- Follow guidance for online home/school learning

All classes will be given a health and hygiene briefing at the start of each day to remind children of the importance of the additional school rules and how they can apply them in school.

Should a child deliberately refuse to follow these routines or threatens to spit at or bite another child or adult in school, then sanctions will be applied in line with Stage 3 of our behaviour policy and parents will be contacted to ensure the safety of their child and that of other children and staff.

A child repeatedly refusing to comply with instructions or spitting at or biting another child or adult in school will be treated as a serious incident under Stage 4 of our behaviour policy and wider sanctions applied.

Fixed term exclusion may be used when a child persistently and intentionally refuses to comply with the arrangements and presents a risk to other children or adults in school.
